Bradley Turner was born in Indianapolis, Indiana, to Georgia Mae Ross Turner and Wilson T.

Turner, Sr. on July 24, 1956. He attended public school in Indianapolis and graduated from Shortridge High School.

Bradley had a special bond and relationship with the cherished mother of three of his children,

Pamela Gamby. They welcomed three children into the world together, Tina Johnson, Rena

England, Bradley Turner, and still-born son, Bryan. Bradley later was united in marriage to ex-

wife Myrinah Turner, in Indianapolis, Indiana. No children were born to their union. Besides

Bradley was last employed at Allied Universal Security Services providing security around the

Painting, and prior to opening that business, he had been employed by IndyGo, as a driver on the Indy Metro bus system.

Bradley professed his belief and love for Christ and joined Jesus Way Open Door Ministry

where he served under the leadership of Pastor Gloria Bonds. He served in the position of

Deacon. He was a faithful and dedicated member of the Ministry and showed his belief in the

value of Christian Education through regular attendance at services and Bible Study. Bradley

was gifted by God as a craftsman. In repayment, he used that gift to edify the Lord by assisting

in the formation of Jesus Way Open Door Ministry. Whether obeying the call of the Lord to

preach the Gospel, completing work in the area of carpentry, plumbing, or painting, you found

that Brad's hands were involved in many aspects of the ministry.
