Carlton C. Lewis, Jr. was born on July 27, 1937, to the late Carlton Lewis Sr. and Odessa Sharp-Lewis in Walnut Grove, Mississippi. He was the third child of eight children.

“CL”, as he was affectionately known to the family and friends, professed a hope in Christ at an early age. He was baptized at St. Damascus Baptist Church in Walnut Grove, Mississippi. CL was active in the church, volunteering his time. He was Sunday School Superintendent and a leader in other functions in the church.

CL attended Leake County Schools and graduated from Leake Agricultural High School in 1954. During high school, CL was employed as a well-digger. He entered the United States Army two days after graduation and remained in active duty three years. After serving in the United States Army, CL moved to Indianapolis, Indiana and was employed at General Motors, retiring after 30 years of service. He was also employed with Indianapolis Police Department for many years. During this time he started the Lewis Motorcycle Escort Service and the Lewis Charter Bus

Transportation Service.

CL was a 32nd Degree Mason of Southern Cross Lodge #39 and belonged to the Shriners, and Royal Arch all of Prince Hall. CL was a member of the CB club and his CB-handle was "Law Man Indiana".
