DaMonte' was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on February 22, 1997 to Dibri L. Davis & Antoine Parker. DaMonte' grew up in Indianapolis and Providence, Kentucky. DaMonte' worked for the United States Postal Service.

DaMonte' would tell the people at his day care, Berry Patch, he was going to his summer home with his Great Grandma Nettie Gaither Davis and great aunt Anna Davis Nall affectionately called "Aunnie". At the day care he learned about God and learned to say all the books of the Bible.

While visiting his great grandmother, Nettie Mae Gaither Davis, in Providence, he joined and was baptized at Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church under Rev, Dwight Young when he was nine years old. As a young boy, he loved going to church and participated in many of its activities.

DaMonte' was also a volunteer for the Kentucky Conference of NAACP Branches and the Webster County Branch of NAACP. He loved his Great Uncle John and attended some seminars with the Indianapolis Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity and volunteered at the Black Expo, in addition to helping him with various projects at his house

At Heather Hills Elementary in Indianapolis, he received a perfect score in the Warren World of Music Contest. While attending Andrew J. Brown Academy, he was selected to participate in the State Math competition. DaMonte' graduated from Connections Academy in 2015 and worked at various jobs until he started working at the Post Office as a temporary employee.

His willingness to work and be a team player resulted in a permanent employment the Post Office where he was loved and respected by coworkers and supervisors alike.

DaMonte' was always a caregiver. He always tried to take care of his mother and would say "I am the man of the house". He would watch over her when she was sick. He loved her dearly. He was a great grandson and took care of his Grandmother Fannie (affectionately call Gmom) and his grandfather, Charles Mitchell and Grandmother, Anna Parker. He loved his father and all of his immediate and extended family and always looked forward to seeing them. He was always willing to help anyone in need. He became very handy with tools and was a pretty good car mechanic and body man.
