Rev. David Singleton Chambers was born in Forest Mississippi on December 7, 1943 to the late Rev. Robert W. Chambers and Mary Louise Ealy. David was the third of six siblings. As a young man of seventeen, David married his childhood Sweetheart and Queen, Versie Mae Johnson, of Morton Mississippi. In 1962, the young couple left Mississippi to begin their new lives in Indianapolis. To this union, the love birds had three children: Theresa, TT, Cynthia, (Cindy) and Curtis Andretti. Rev. Chambers professed his hope in Christ at an early age. He was one of God's Mightiest Soldiers, as he served tirelessly in church ministries. As a member of Little Zion Baptist Church, Rev.
