Katrina Louise Shute, affectionately known as "Trina, Momma, MeMe, Momma Trina, Ms. Shute" was born on September 29, 1956, in Indianapolis, Indiana, to the late Robert W. Becoming a wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother were among Trina's most cherished accomplishments, as she deeply loved her family.

Trina professed her faith in Christ at an early age at Mount Pilgrim Baptist Church. She had a passion for sewing, crafting, gardening, cooking, playing slots and cards. She loved activities that allowed her to use her hands to make, create, or fix things. She was the go to
