Marian affectionately known as "Regina" received her education in the Indianapolis Public School system, graduated from Crispus Attucks High and went on to attend and graduate college at Indianapolis General hospital school of nursing where she became one of the first four (4) Negro girls to receive her Cap at the Capping Exercises.

Regina professed and demonstrated her love for Christ at an early age and later became a member of New Light Missionary Baptist Church, where she faithfully attended and served until God called her home.

Marian Regina, married the late great Jacob E. Jones Sr. in (19--) and happily became Marian Regina Jones, together they raised, loved and cared for 7 children. Regina was a loving and dedicated daughter, sister, wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and individual in general, she had a pleasant spirit, with a big heart, and a smile that would brighten any dark situation.

Regina worked and retired as a LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse) at Peoples Citizen Health Care Clinic but cared for and unconditionally loved the people all of her life.
