With profound love and deep reverence, we honor the life of Pastor Tracy Yvette Marbley, a devoted servant

of God, beloved mother, grandmother, sister, and friend. Pastor Marbley transitioned peacefully on September

12, 2025, leaving behind a legacy of unwavering faith, compassionate leadership, and spiritual strength.

Born to the late LB Marbley Sr. and Betty Jean Marbley, Tracy embraced her faith early in life, making a

personal decision to follow Jesus that would shape her journey and inspire countless others. She was a prayer

warrior, a Bible woman of God, and a beacon of light in every space she entered.

Pastor Marbley faithfully served in numerous church roles throughout her life —choir member, devotion leader,

church clerk, missionary, Sunday School Superintendent, and Church Administrator. She founded True Word

of God Ministries, led a powerful Prison Ministry, and helped establish structure in churches such as Holy

Cross Church of God in Christ. Her voice reached city leaders, and her heart

always leaned toward the underserved.

A proud alumna of IUPUI, she was licensed and ordained under Bishop Laverne Tyson of New Beginning Ministries. She also served her community through roles at the Marion County Health Department, IUPUI School of Law Clinic, and the Marion County Children's Bureau, from which she retired.

Pastor Marbley was a self-proclaimed interior decorator, a writer of short stories, and a woman who loved deeply and laughed freely. She was known for her radiant smile, her wisdom-filled prayers, and her favorite saying: "Warning before destruction" (Proverbs 16:1–33). Her phone was set with prayer alarms, and her heart was always tuned to the needs of others.

Our mother rarely complained, often simply saying, "Such is life." She would always affirm, "I'm great." She often identified with Jeremiah, the weeping prophet, passionately crying out for souls to be saved. Filled with wisdom, she continuously sought guidance through prayer.

She was preceded in death by her brother, Larry Bernard Marbley, and granddaughter, Actshiona Lanaya Davis (daughter of Ronald Davis Sr).
